



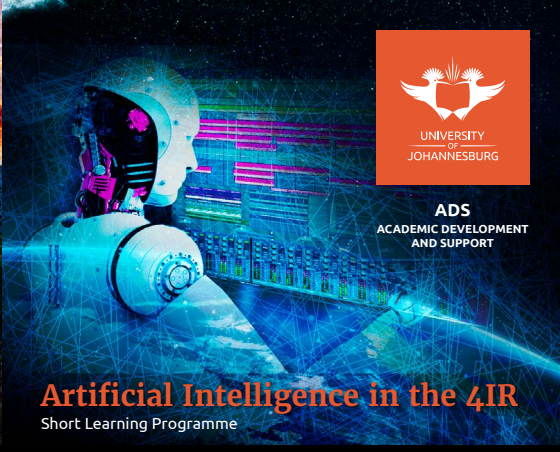

STEP 1: Go to uLink: <https://ulink.uj.ac.za/>

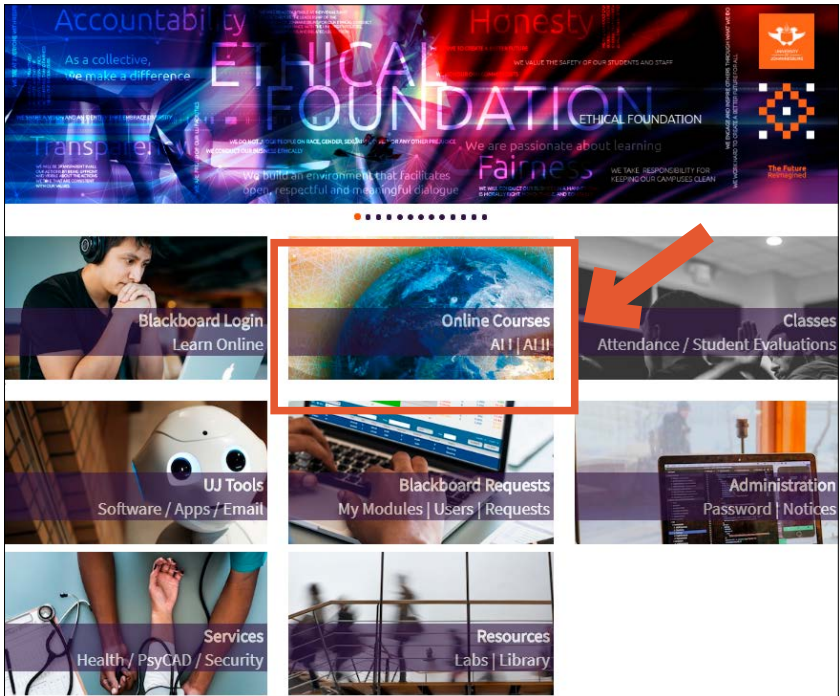
STEP 2: Log in to uLink using your credentials.

- If you are a **staff member**, use your staff username.

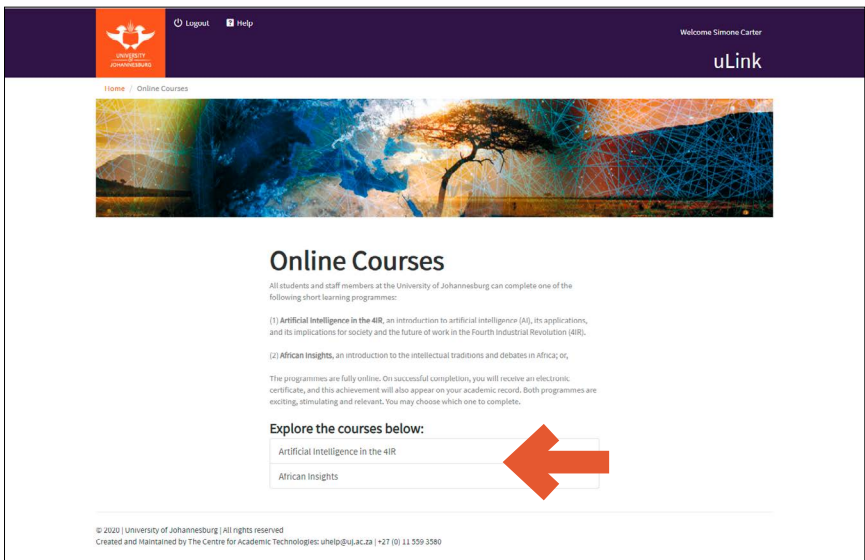

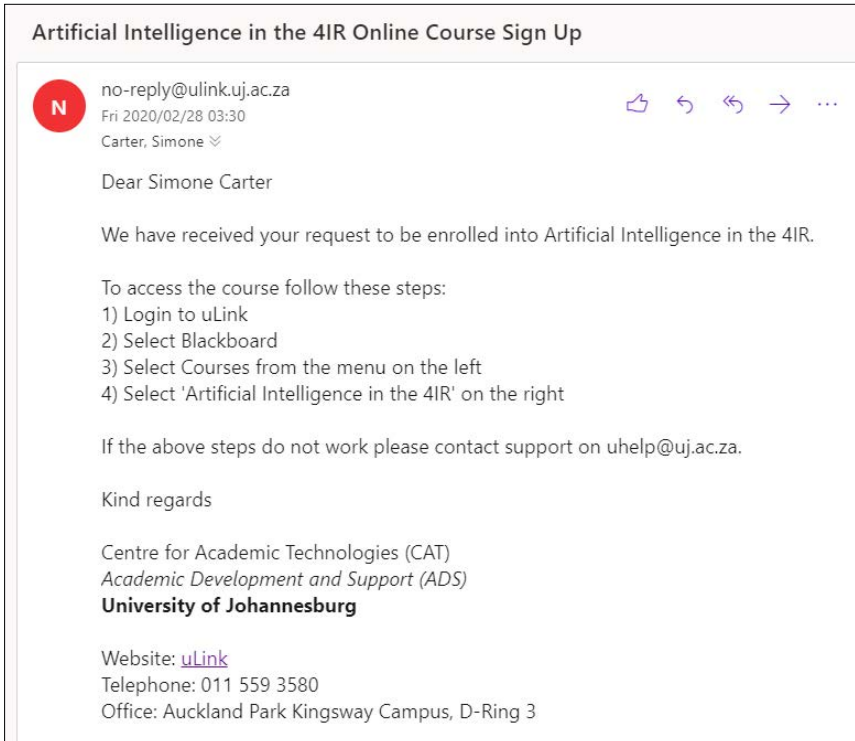

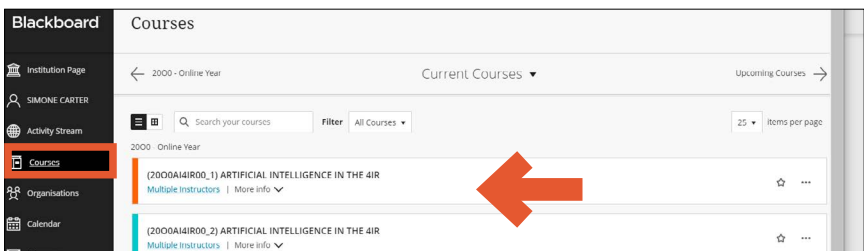
